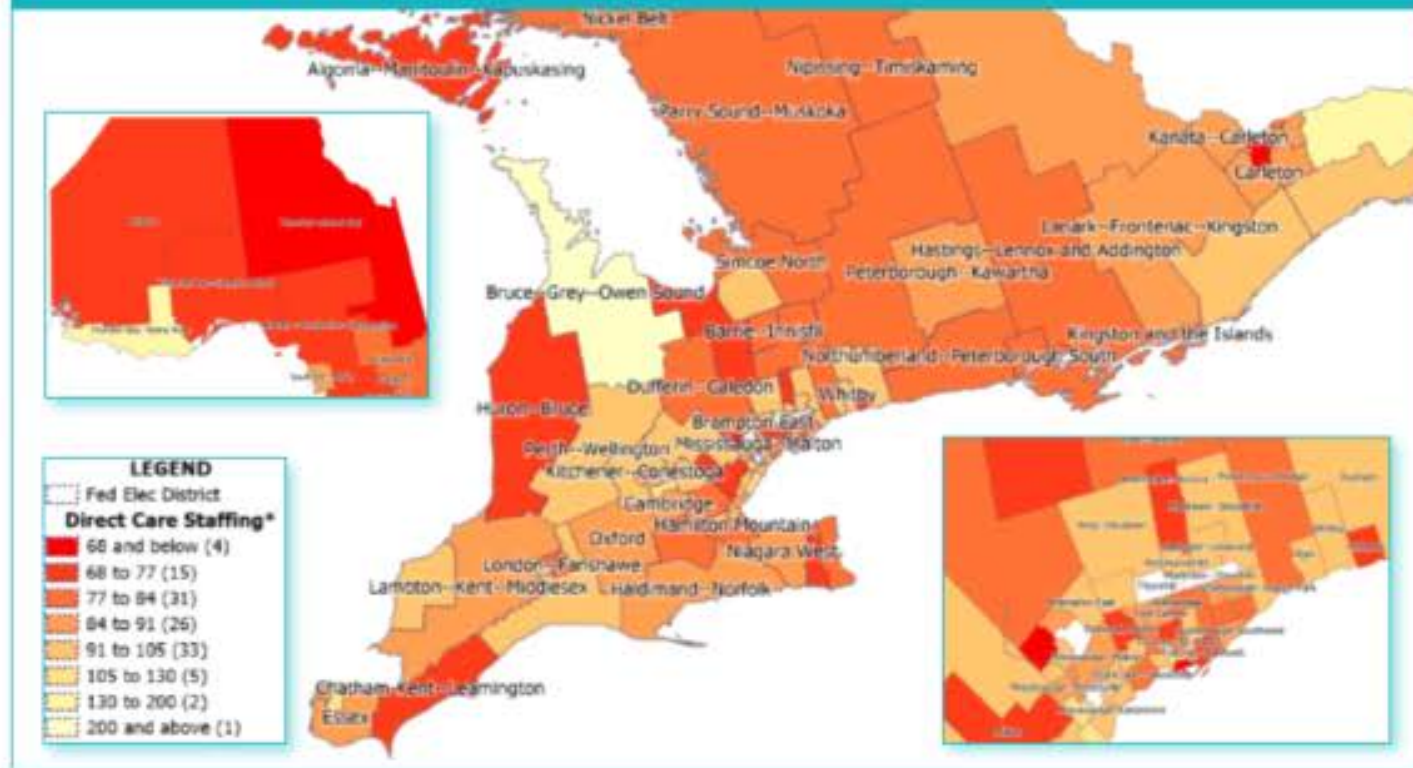
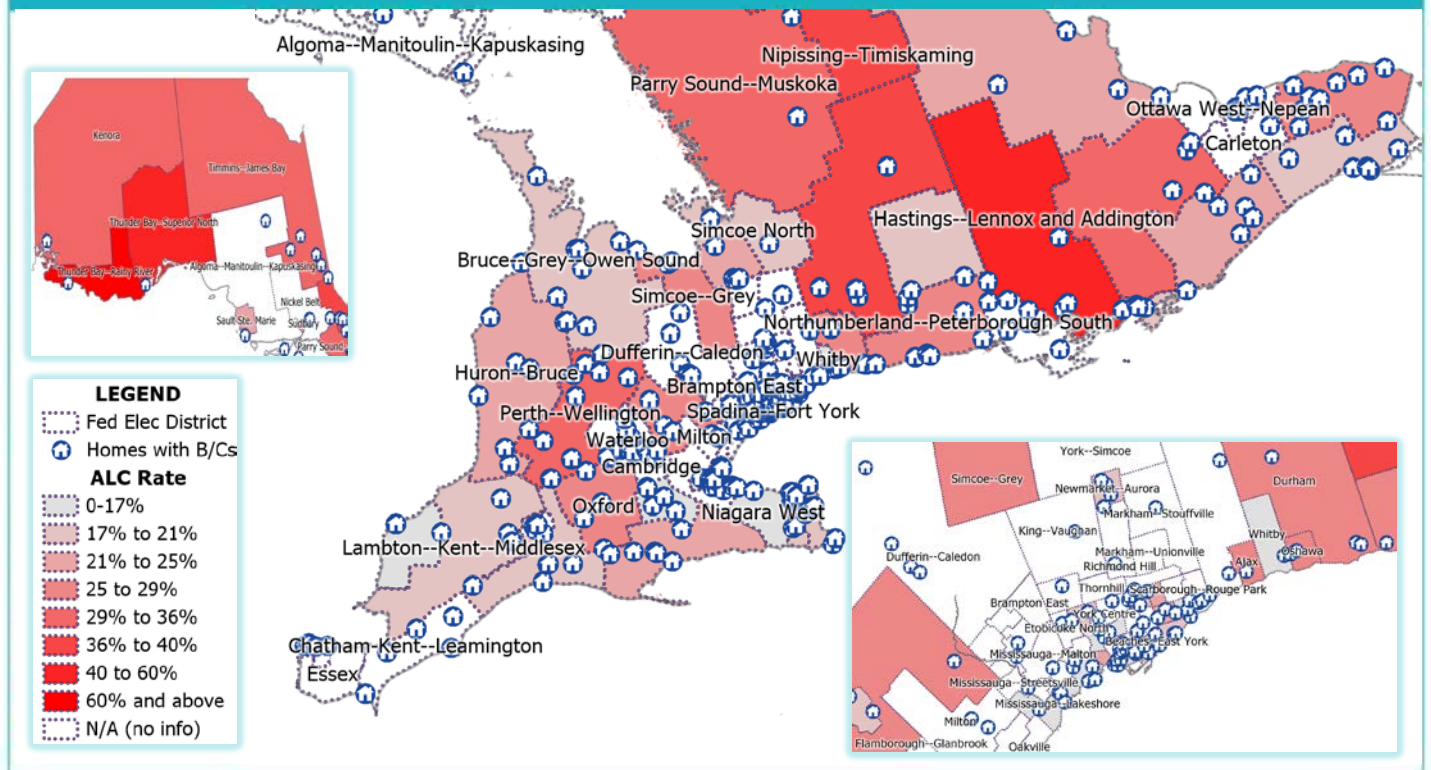


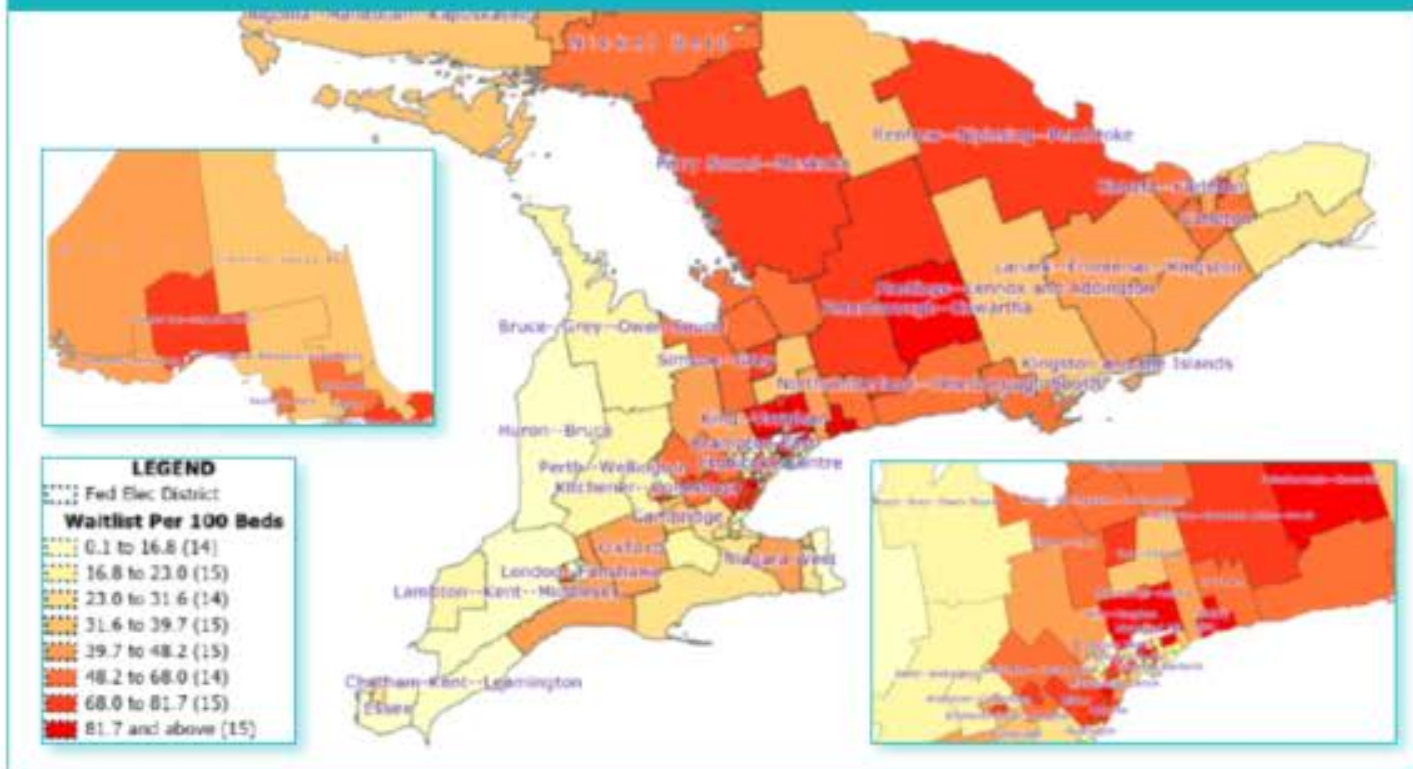
DIRECT CARE STAFF PER 100 BEDS

COMMUNITIES UNDER HIGHEST PRESSURE

Of the 124 communities in Ontario shown on these maps, more than 25% (32 communities) are experiencing at least 2 out of 4 of the following system pressures:

- Higher wait lists for long-term care beds
- Higher staffing shortages
- Higher number of beds needing redevelopment
- Higher alternate level of care rates
